Creating an Account




Click on - Log In

Fill in all required fields.




Click on – Create my new account.


Enrolling and Taking Courses

Select the course you would like to take.


For this example, we will enroll in Advocate Core






Click on - Click to Enroll

Course Components (You must complete each section to unlock and move on the next section)






Once you have completed the section, click "Click here to start next section".

You can re-visit your completed or in-progress courses at any time clicking on the "My Courses" Tab across the top.


Certificates and Grades
